



Adopteen Camp-Conference Scholarship Application

Thank you for applying for an Adopteen Scholarship! We have worked very hard to get this dream of ours up and running, and are very excited to see your submissions!

To Apply

Fill out the information and sign the release form requested on the next page. You will have two options to select from. Attach either your essay or your creative piece along with the application.

The first option is to write a short essay (up to 1,000 words) in response to the following prompt: What do you want to be known for in your life?

The second option is one creative piece that you believe best conveys your identity as an adoptee. This creative piece may be a picture, video, song, painting, short story, poem, journal entry, or even a photograph. There are no restrictions to what sort of creative piece we are looking for, only that it should encompass your identity as an adoptee. **Please also include a short 100 word blurb about your piece and include a title.**

Unconventional Projects: For submissions that are not easily attached to an email instead of mailed, such as sculptures or other large format pieces, please contact Adopteen at info@adopteen.org for information on how best to submit your work.

Eligibility and Requirements

Anyone eligible to register for an Adopteen Camp-Conferences may apply for an Adopteen Scholarship. That is to say, any adoptee (regardless of country of origin or adoption agency) over the age of 13 may submit an application. The exception to this rule is any individual on the Adopteen Leadership Committee. Adopteen Leadership Committee members are not eligible to receive an additional scholarship.

Limit one scholarship per family. Scholarship funds apply only towards the registration fee of an Adopteen Camp-Conference, and must be used this year (2017). Scholarship winners who have already registered and paid the full registration fee will receive reimbursements for the scholarship amount.

Applicants are encouraged to register for the Camp-Conference that they wish to attend as soon as possible, rather than wait for the results of the scholarship process – if a Conference meets its maximum of 100, registration will be closed, regardless of whether a prospective attendee that did not register in time wins a scholarship.

Submissions must be received by **end of business day (5PM MDT) Friday, May 5th** for Adopteen Denver, and **Friday, June 2nd** for Adopteen Wilmington. If your submission is mailed, please ensure that it will be

delivered to *Adopteen* at 6920 South Holly Circle, Centennial, CO 80112 by this day. Submissions will be reviewed by an impartial five-person committee, and winners will be announced on **Friday, May 12th** for Adopteen Denver and **Friday, June 9th** for Adopteen Wilmington.

By submitting a piece to Adopteen, Adopteen reserves the right to feature your piece however it sees fit, including but not limited to: promotional materials, social media, and Adopteen Shop merchandise.
